Important Information

As you may be already aware new Covid guidelines came into place this week. As a church we have been informed to continue to be careful, especially as many vulnerable people may be present in the congregation. We have had evidence recently when a person in the congregation informed us that they had tested positive having attended church that morning.

A new risk assessment has been produced and whereas we cannot insist on the continued use of face masks we are advising that they are still worn when moving around church, receiving communion and singing. Also sitting spaced from another person is still advisable. Anyone feeling vulnerable can also choose to sit in the right hand aisle of the church as an extra safety measure.

Hand sanitising gel will still be used, and attendance names noted for the purpose of track and trace in light of an incident.
